

ADULT BIBLE FELLOWSHIPS

We invite you to join any of our Adult Bible Fellowships (ABFs) for a time of Bible study, prayer and building friendships. A variety of classes are offered to meet the needs of adults from college-age to senior saints! You are free to attend and join an ABF at any time.

What is an ABF?

- A group of 10-30 people who experience Biblical fellowship and community with each other.
- They meet weekly on Sunday mornings at 9am or 10:45am.
- Usually are made up of people in similar family and life stage.
- They are led by a team that shares teaching, fellowship and care.

What does an ABF do?

- Engage in Bible study together, led by a gifted teacher. Usually you are studying a book of the Bible.
- Each week includes a time for sharing and praying with and for each other.
- Friendships are encouraged and grow, often leading to spending time together outside of class time.
