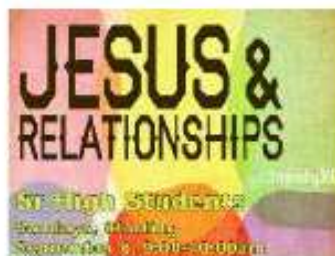


Jr and Sr High Youth Group

ROOTED - On Wednesday nights beginning September 9 students will begin a 10 week Rooted discipleship group experience. Over the 10 weeks students will have weekly small group experiences together, a devotional to go through on your own time, and learning to put 7 spiritual rhythms in practice. These powerful experiences will equip students to open their heart to the most important relationship they will ever experience – their relationship with God!



JH SUNDAY SCHOOL - Jr High students will begin a study titled "Jesus and Identity" on Sunday, September 6 from 9:00-10:00am. Jesus and Identity will give students four snapshots of what it means to find identity in Christ. What it means to be salt and light; Jesus defines greatness differently than the world; their true purpose is found in "remaining" in Christ; and that Jesus wants to use them to reach the lost.



SH SUNDAY SCHOOL - Sr High students will begin a study titled "Jesus and Relationships" on Sunday, September 6 from 9:00-10:00am. Jesus and Relationships will teach students that understanding and grace are keys to Christ-centered relationships; that there is no room for anger or hostility in Christ-centered relationships; that Jesus laid out the right way to deal with conflict in a relationship; and that their relationship with Jesus must be the number one relationship in their lives.
