He loves and cares about us deeply; He understands us completely; He has the mercy and grace to enable us to live as Fully Devoted Followers of Christ. With that in mind, we can approach His throne of Grace with hope and confidence.

- 1) Hebrews 4:14-16 refers to Jesus as our Great High Priest. We can gain insight as to what all this means by looking at the OT passages on the High Priest. Look up the following passages and note your observations.
 - **Exodus 28:11-12.** The High Priest had two stones attached to the shoulders of his outer garment symbolizing carrying the People of Israel's burdens to God in prayer.
