They worked in West Kalimantan with the Embaloh people until 1996. After the New and part of the Old Testament were translated and the Church was established, the Sharps moved to the Philippines. Ginny had already been the field Translation Consultant for 15 years. They lived in the Philippines and worked with the Tala-Andig people in Mindanao for a number of years before moving to the coastal city of Butuan.

In 2009, the Sharps returned to the US to minister to their family. Ginny continued as a Translation Consultant for a time but has now turned that responsibility over to someone she trained.
